The meeting was called to order by the Vice Chair – Robyn White.

Robyn turned the time over to Principal Forsgren. We discussed:

Reports about Standing Duties for School Improvement:

- Trust Lands: Review SIP/Trust Lands Plan Updated Budget
- Reading Improvements SPED Help in Place DIBELS data analysis
  - We have seen an 11% (67-78) improvement in scores from beginning test to the mid-year assessment, FANTASTIC! We are trying to achieve a year end goal of 80.
- Technology Advancement
  - A TV has been added to the lobby of the school. This wasn't done through trust land funds, but is in alignment with our other technology advancements that we've made as a committee. There has also been a new copier placed in the work room, but the duplicator has broken down and needs to be replaced.

Miscellaneous Business:

- After school clubs computer science report
  - Principal Forsgren is looking at the 'Code to the Future' program. This is an optional seven week course that teaches kids the basics of coding. The cost is \$13 per session for each child attending, which would be paid by the parent. The community council was supportive of offering it.
- School Store fundraiser
  - School Store is a website that allows parents to shop online, and a portion of the proceeds is sent to the school. The council was not supportive of another fundraising program.
- Plan for Next Year
  - There has been a change for a per-school accreditation to a district wide accreditation; one outcome of this is that we now need to be supportive of district wide goals. The district has a goal to reduce chronic absenteeism which as a school we need to support. Principal Forsgren asked us to as a committee to brainstorm how we make a difference for the next meeting.
